

BY-LAW NO. 97.

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE TO PROVIDE  
FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN LAND FOR THE PURPOSE  
OF A CEMETERY..

UNDER THE AUTHORITY and subject to the provisions  
of Section 273(e) of the Town and Village Act, being Chapter 338 of the  
Revised Statues of Alberta, 1955, and amendments thereto, the Council  
of the Town of Slave Lake duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- (a) That the Council does hereby authorize and require the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer on behalf of the Town of Slave Lake to effect the purchase of all that portion of the South West Quarter of Section thirty (30) Township Seventy Two (72) Range five (5) West of the Fifth Meridian in the Province of Alberta, Dominion of Canada as follow COMMENCING AT THE NORTH WEST CORNER OF THE SAID QUARTER SECTION, THENCE EASTERLY ALONG THE NORTH BOUNDARY OF THE SAID QUARTER SECTION A DISTANCE OF FIVE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY ONE (581) FEET, THENCE SOUTHERLY AND PARALLEL TO THE WEST BOUNDARY OF THE SAID QUARTER SECTION A DISTANCE OF FOUR HUNDRED AND EIGHTEEN (418) FEET, THENCE WESTERLY AND PARALLEL TO THE SAID NORTH BOUNDARY A DISTANCE OF FIVE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY ONE (581) FEET, OR LESS, TO A POINT ON THE SAID WEST BOUNDARY, THENCE NORTHERLY AND ALONG THE SAID WEST BOUNDARY A DISTANCE OF FOUR HUNDRED AND EIGHTEEN (418) FEET, TO THE POINT OF COMMENCEMENT, CONTAINING FIVE AND FIFTY EIGHT HUNDREDS (5.58) ACRES MORE OR LESS RESERVING UNTO HER MAJESTY ALL MINES AND MINERALS TOGETHER WITH FULL POWER TO WORK THE SAME, TO BE USED FOR CEMETERY PURPOSES ONLY.
- (b) That the purchase price to be paid for the said cemetery shall be exactly the sum of one Dollar (1) plus cost of Transfer, if any.
- (c) That this by-law shall come into effect immediately upon its passing thereof.
