

BY - LAW N O 48

A BY-LAW PROVIDING FOR DISCOUNTS ON CURRENT TAXES.

Under the powers conferred upon it by Section 374 of the Town and Village Act, 1955, being Chapter 338 of the Statutes of Alberta, the Council of the Village of SLAVE LAKE, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

'That there shall be allowed on payment of taxes which become due and payable in the year in which payment is made, a discount of six (6) per centum (%), if payment is made on or before the second (2nd) day of October 1964.'

Read a first time this 3rd day of April 1964.

Read a second time this 3rd day of April 1964.

Read a third time and finally passed this 3rd day of April 1964.

THE PLANNING ACT, 1963

THE VILLAGE OF SLAVE LAKE  
MINISTERIAL ORDER

WHEREAS, there is in effect within the Village of Slave Lake a zoning bylaw (Bylaw No. 49) enacted by the Council pursuant to The Planning Act, 1963 and

WHEREAS, certain lands situated in Improvement District No. 124 were annexed to the Village pursuant to an order (Order No. 1444) issued by the Local Authorities Board, dated August 19th, 1964 and

WHEREAS, there is in effect within Improvement District No. 124 Development Control Order and Schedule No. 1, made by the Minister pursuant to The Planning Act, 1963 and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the provisions of the said Development Control Order and Schedule No. 1 shall continue in force and effect for the said lands annexed to the Village until a new zoning bylaw comes into force;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ALFRED J. HOOKE, Minister of Municipal Affairs, pursuant to the powers vested in me by Section 141 of The Planning Act, 1963, DO HEREBY ORDER:

The said lands annexed to the Village of Slave Lake shall be subject to the provisions of Development Control and Schedule No. 1 until such time as the Council of the said Village shall enact a new zoning bylaw;

In accordance with the provisions of The Planning Act, 1963, the Council shall administer and enforce the provisions of Development Control Order and Schedule No. 1 in the manner provided in the said Order and Schedule;
