

BY-LAW NO.21

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF SLAVE LAKE TO  
AUTHORIZE THE SEVERAL RATES OF TAXATION  
IMPOSED FOR ALL PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 1962

WHEREAS, the total requirements of the Village  
of Slave Lake as shown in the Estimates of Revenue and  
Expenditures are as follows:

Municipal	\$8,790.78
School Requisition	\$7,068.00
Municipal Hospital Requisition	\$1,347.82

WHEREAS, the total assessment of land, buildings  
and improvements amounts to \$266,780.00 and

WHEREAS, the estimated revenue other than  
taxation is \$6,155.00, and

WHEREAS, the rates hereinafter set out are  
deemed necessary to provide the amounts required for  
municipal, school and hospital purposes, after making  
due allowance for the amount of taxes which may  
reasonably be expected to remain unpaid.

NOW THEREFOR, by virtue of the power conferred  
upon it by Section 353 of the Town and Village Act, 1955,  
the Council of the Village of Slave Lake Enacts as Follows:

THAT the Secretary-Treasurer, be and she is hereby  
authorized and required to levy the following rates of  
taxation on the assessed value of all lands, buildings  
and improvements as shown on the assessment and tax roll:

Municipal Purposes - 9 mills on the dollar

School Purposes - 32 mills on the dollar


Municipal Hospital  
Purposes - 4 mills on the dollar

Read a first time this 4th day of May, 1962.

Read a third time and finally passed this 4th day
