

BY - LAW NO. 25.

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF SLAVE LAKE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING FIRST STREET WEST FROM THE S.W. CORNER OF LOT 16 IN BLOCK 3 TO THE N.W. CORNER OF LOT 2 IN BLOCK 4, FOURTH AVENUE AND ALL LANES IN BLOCK 3 AS SHOWN ON REGISTERED PLAN NO. 1794 E.T. BEACH GROVE, SLAVE LAKE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 269 OF THE TOWN AND VILLAGE ACT, CHAPTER 338, R.S.A. 1955.

WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council to pass this by-law was served by personal delivery at least two weeks prior to the date fixed for the passing of the by-law upon the occupiers of and persons registered as owners of or otherwise interested in the lands abutting upon First Street West, Fourth Avenue and all lanes in block 3 as shown on Registered Plan No. 1794 E.T. Beach Grove, Slave Lake :

WHEREAS, a notice was published in the High Prairie Progress on July 28th and August 4th and posted in six locations within the Village, the last of such publications being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the by-law;

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the Village of Slave Lake duly assembled enacts as follows;

All that portion of first street West from the S.W. corner of Lot 16 in Block 3 to the N.W. corner of Lot 2 in Block four, Fourth Avenue and all lanes in Block 3 as shown on Registered Plan No. 1794 E.T., Beach Grove, Slave Lake shall be closed to all traffic as and from the date of the Final passing of this by-law.
