

BY-LAW NO. 28

of

THE VILLAGE OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A RETURNING OFFICER FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
TAKING THE VOTE OF PROPRIETARY ELECTORS UPON BY-LAWS NO.  
15 AND NO. 16 AND FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE SAID VOTE

WHEREAS the Council has given first reading to By-laws No.  
15 and No. 16, providing for the issuance of debentures of the Village in  
the amounts of \$113,450.00 and \$61,500.00 respectively;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Town and  
Village Act the said By-law requires the assent of two-thirds of the  
proprietary electors voting thereon;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SLAVE  
LAKE IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT JOHN M. PICKARD of the Village of  
Slave Lake is hereby appointed Returning Officer for the purpose of taking  
the vote of proprietary electors of the Village on By-laws Nos. 15 and 16.
2. THAT SATUR day, the 3<sup>RD</sup> day of MARCH, 1962,  
between the hours of TEN o'clock in the forenoon and SEVEN o'clock in the  
afternoon, is hereby fixed as the day and hour for taking the vote of the  
proprietary electors on the said By-laws.
3. THAT for the said purpose a poll shall be open at THE  
VILLAGE OFFICE In the said Village.
4. THAT the Returning Officer shall at the VILLAGE OFFICE  
on SATUR day, the 3<sup>RD</sup> day of MARCH, 1962, at 7:15 o'clock in  
AFTERNOON the forenoon, sum up the votes given for and against the By-laws and declare  
the result.

READ a first time and passed provisionally in Council this  
2<sup>ND</sup> day of FEBRUARY 1962.
