

BY-LAW NO. 7

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF SLAVE LAKE TO LICENSE AND REGULATE BUSINESSES,  
TRADES, AND OCCUPATIONS AS ENUMERATED HEREIN.

UNDER THE AUTHORITY and subject to the provisions of  
Section 329 (a) of the Town and Village Act, the Council of the  
& 330 (1)  
Village of Slave Lake duly assembled hereby enacts:

1. No person shall conduct or carry on any business, trade or occupation as listed herein in the Village of Slave Lake who is not the holder of a valid subsisting license for that business, trade or occupation issued pursuant to this by-law.
2. Every license shall expire on the 31st day of December following the date of issuance thereof; and there shall be paid at the time of the application for a license a fee in the amount as set out below: -
3. All provisions of the Town and Village Act and amendments thereto which apply to the issuance of all licenses issued under this by-law, and to holders thereof, and to all businesses, trades, or occupations enumerated herein within the corporated limits of the Village of Slave Lake; this by-law shall be conducted in force each year until repealed.
