

BY-LAW NO. 8

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF SLAVE LAKE TO  
AUTHORIZE THE SEVERAL RATES OF TAXATION  
IMPOSED FOR ALL PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 1961

WHEREAS, the total requirements of the Village  
of Slave Lake as shown in the Estimates of Revenue and  
Expenditure are as follows:

Municipal	\$3,126.40
School Requisition	3,773.00
Municipal Hospital	
Requisition	471.60

WHEREAS, the total assessment of land, buildings  
and improvements (and personal property) amounts to  
\$234,855.00 and

WHEREAS, the estimated revenue other than from  
taxation is \$5,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the rates hereinafter set out are  
deemed necessary to provide the amounts required for  
municipal, school and hospital purposes, after making  
due allowance for the amount of taxes which may reasonably  
be expected to remain unpaid.

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the power conferred  
upon it by Section 353 of The Town and Village Act, 1955,  
the Council of the Village of Slave Lake enacts as follows:

THAT the secretary-treasurer, be and he is hereby  
authorized and required to levy the following rates of  
taxation on the assessed value of all lands, buildings  
and improvements (and personal property) as shown on  
the assessment and tax roll:

*28-10*  
Municipal Purposes - 27 mills on the dollar  
School Purposes - 32 mills on the dollar  
Municipal Hospital  
Purposes - 4 mills on the dollar

Read a first time this 9th day of June, 1961

Read a second time this 9th day of June, 1961

Read a third time and finally passed this 14th day of July  
1961.
