

A By-Law authorizing the cancellation of uncollectible arrears of taxes.

WHEREAS, there appears on the assessment and tax role of the Village of Slave Lake, certain arrears of taxes, which the Council deems uncollectible, and

WHEREAS, Section 394 of the Town and Village Act, being Chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1951, authorizes a Council to pass a by-law subject to the approval of the Minister to cancel arrears of taxes which are no longer secured by a charge against land or other property and which are no longer collectible from the person taxes

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Slave Lake duly assembled enacts as follows:

THAT, the arrears of taxes listed hereunder be cancelled for the reasons set out and that the Secretary Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to cancel same from the assessment and tax roll after this by-law has been finally passed and approved by the Minister.
