

A BY-LAW PROVIDING FOR DISCOUNTS ON CURRENT TAXES.


Under the powers conferred upon it by Section 374 of the Town and Village Act, 1955 being Chapter 338 of the Statutes of Alberta, the Council of the Village of Slave Lake, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

That there shall be allowed on payment of taxes which become due and payable in the year in which payment is made, a discount of six (6) per centum (%) if payment is made on or before the eighteenth (18th) day of November 1961.

Read a first time this 14th day of July 1961.

Read a second time this 14th day of July 1961.

Read a third time and finally passed this 14th day of July 1961

WHEREAS, a by-law to provide a discount for the prepayment of current taxes is required to be passed or amended prior to the first day of May in any year as provided by section 374 of The Town and Village Act being chapter 338, R.S.A., 1955; and


WHEREAS, due to the inexperience of the council of the Village of Slave Lake which was incorporated as at January 1st, 1961 the by-law to provide a discount for the prepayment of current taxes was not passed prior to the first day of May; and

WHEREAS, the council of the Village of Slave Lake has requested the undersigned to extend the date for passing a by-law providing for a discount for the prepayment of current taxes; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to grant this request.

NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned by virtue of the authority vested in him under the provisions of section 5 of The Town and Village Act, chapter 338, R.S.A., 1955 DOES HEREBY ORDER that the date for passing a by-law authorizing discounts for the prepayment of current taxes by the council of the Village of Slave Lake be extended to the fourteenth day of July, 1961.
