The purpose of the Slave Lake Regional Subdivision Development Appeal Board is to hear appeals from decisions made by the development authority and subdivision authority of the respective municipality of which the filed appeal originates from. The board is comprised of five municipalities, that appoint public members to represent their community.

There are no members of Council on this board.

How to become a member?

Appointment of Town of Slave Lake members to the Slave Lake Regional Subdivision Development Appeal Board is done by Town of Slave Lake Council.

The term of a member appointment is 3 years.
